

EGRESS OPENING FORMULAS FOR VINYL WINDOWS

Egress Code is an essential building code to follow on all construction projects. By law, Egress Windows need to be large enough to allow entry and escape for a fully equipped firefighter. By code, every habitable room and basement must contain at least one egress window.

EGRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS

- Bottom of an Egress window cannot exceed 44" from the finished floor
- The minimum daylight opening meets or exceeds 5.7 sq ft
- The minimum window opening height is 24"
- The minimum window opening width is 20"
- Please check with local building department for updated & additional egress code requirements. NorthEast will not be held liable if local building codes differ or change over time.
